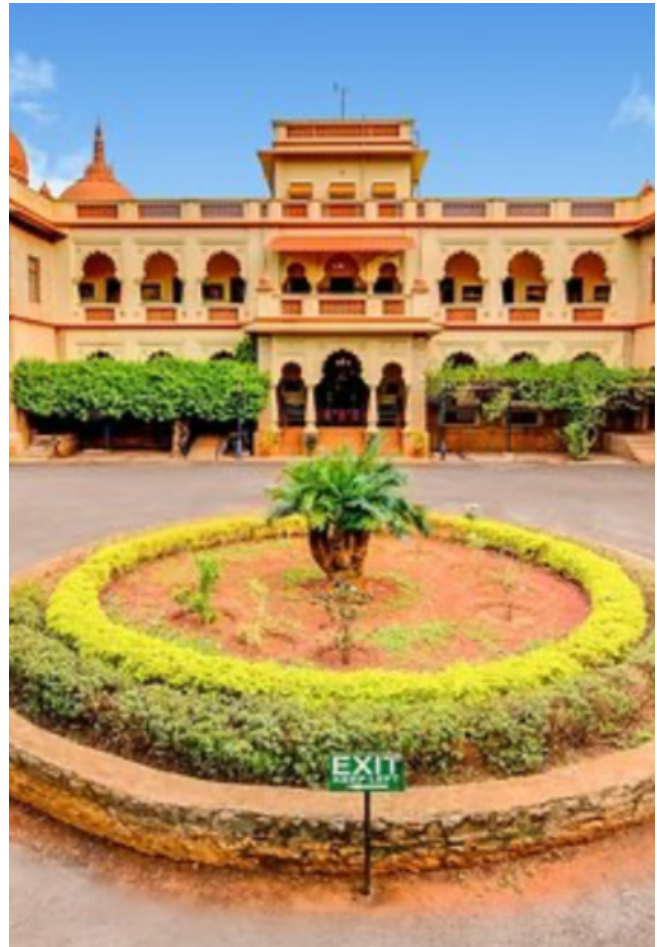


Image above - Lemon's palace's front garden and the area where guests would drive up in cars to greet or talk to Lemon.
