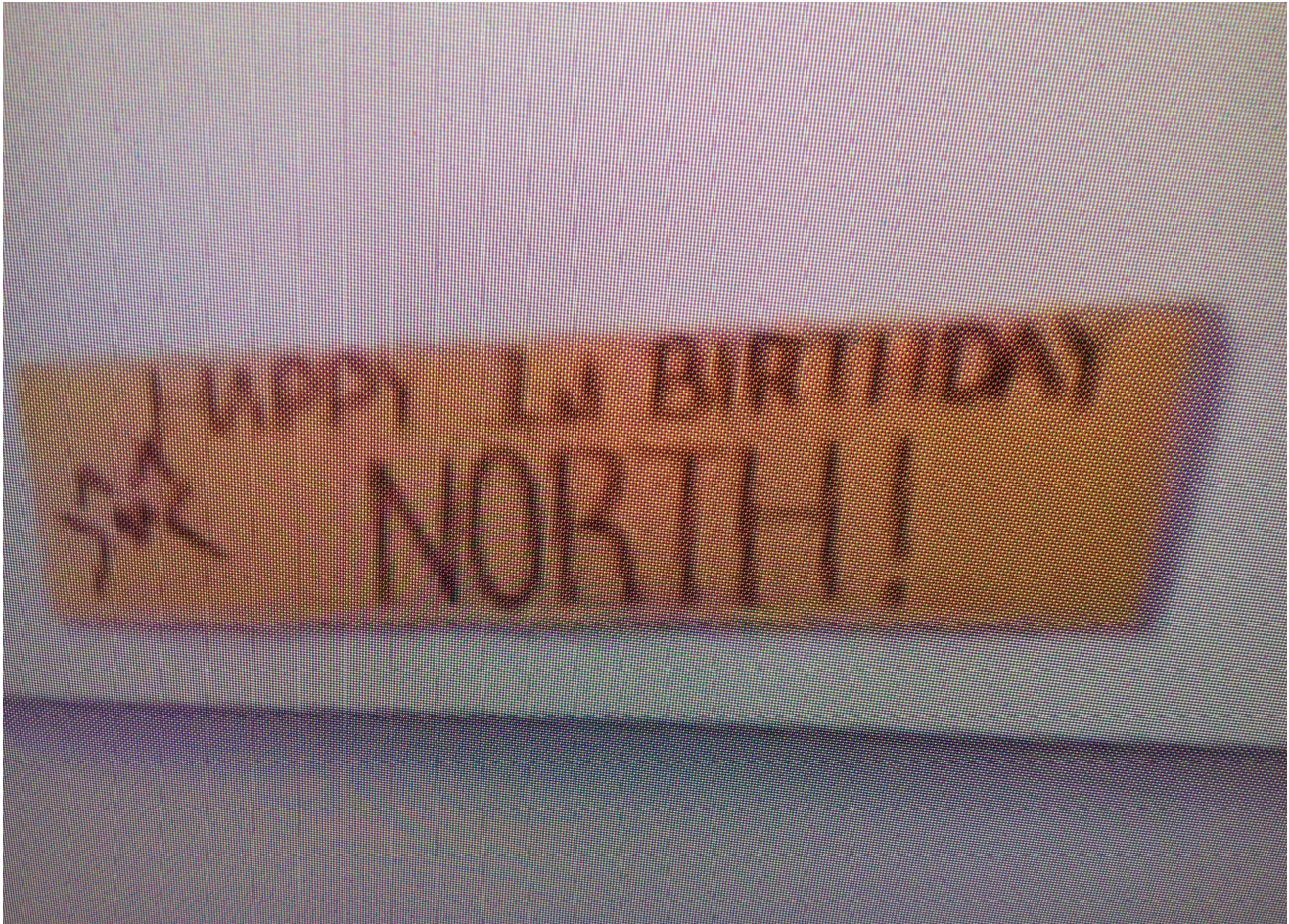

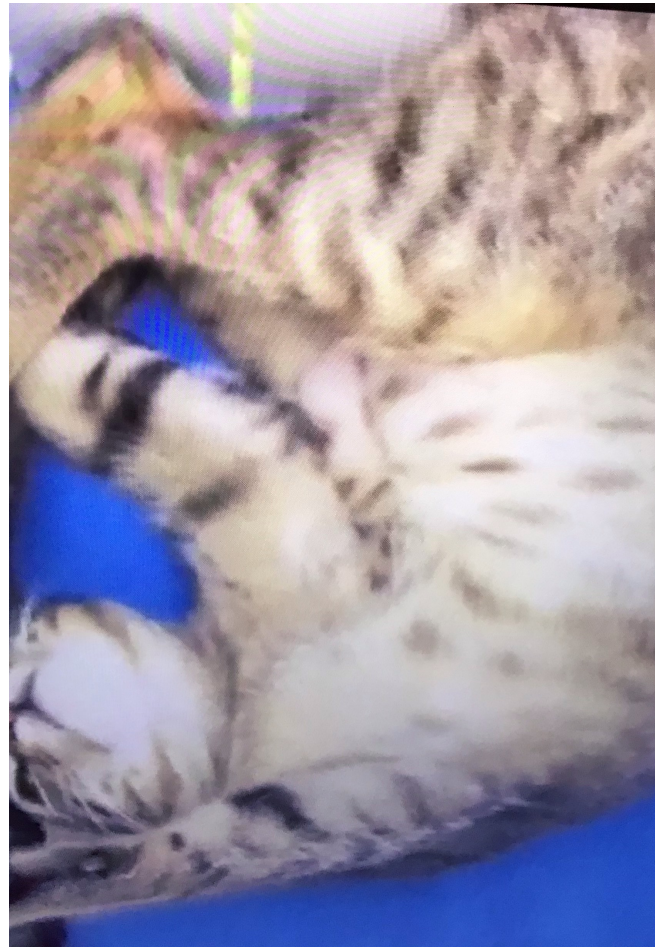


Image above - A birthday photo of North.
