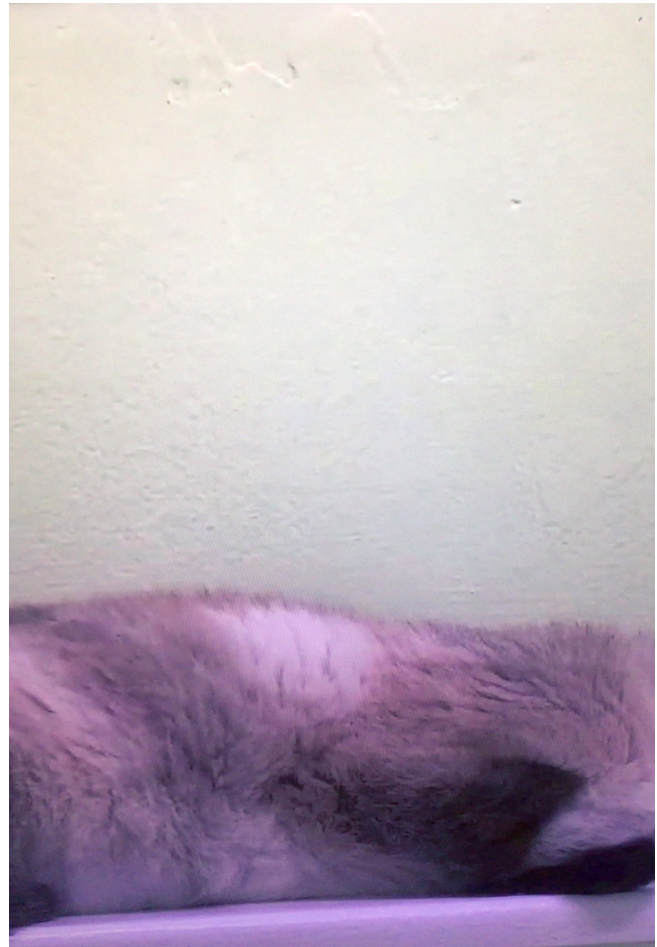


Image above - Lunch, who’s dreaming about going to see Cathamilton live in the theaters.
