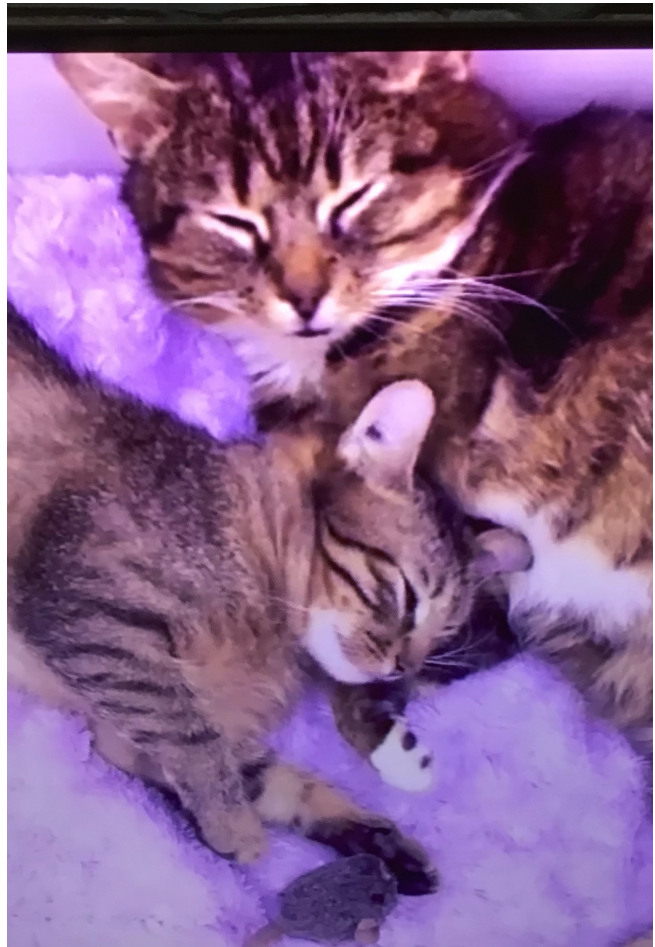


Image above - Harvey and North, who have it easy right now compared to Rudy and Judy's predicament.
