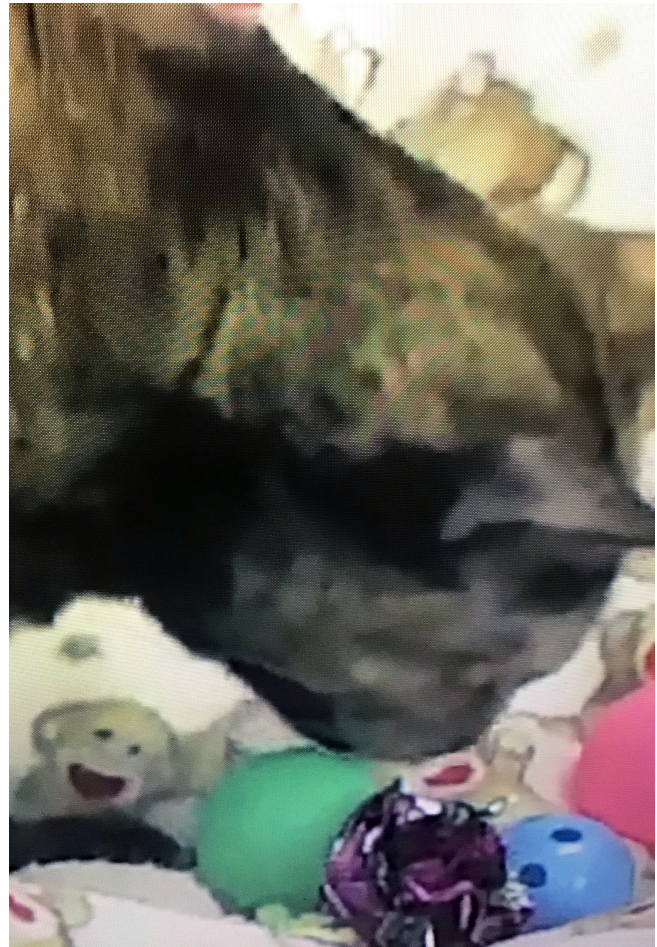


Image above - Judy, who has not eaten anything and only has drank 1 glass of water in 3 days.
