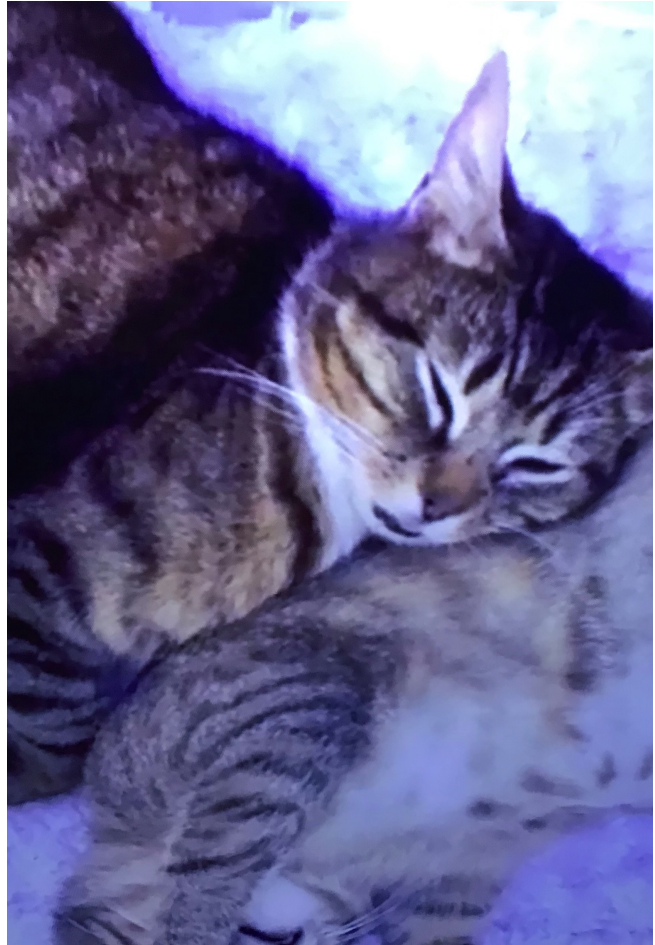


Image above - Harvey, who’s enjoying North’s company - as a pillow.
