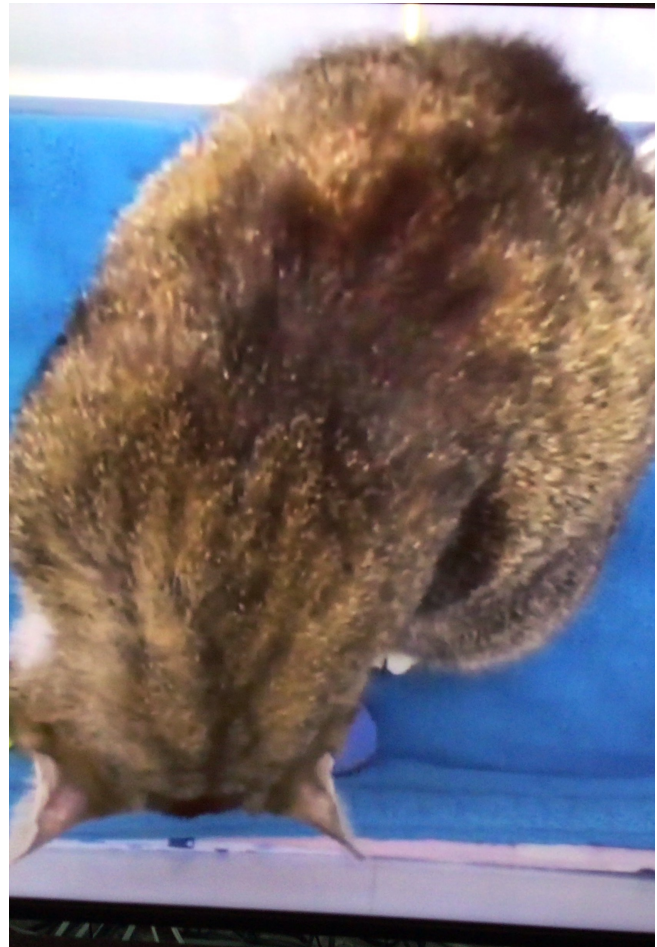


Image above - Harvey, who's annoyed that he had to leave all of his sugar cubes in his camper.
