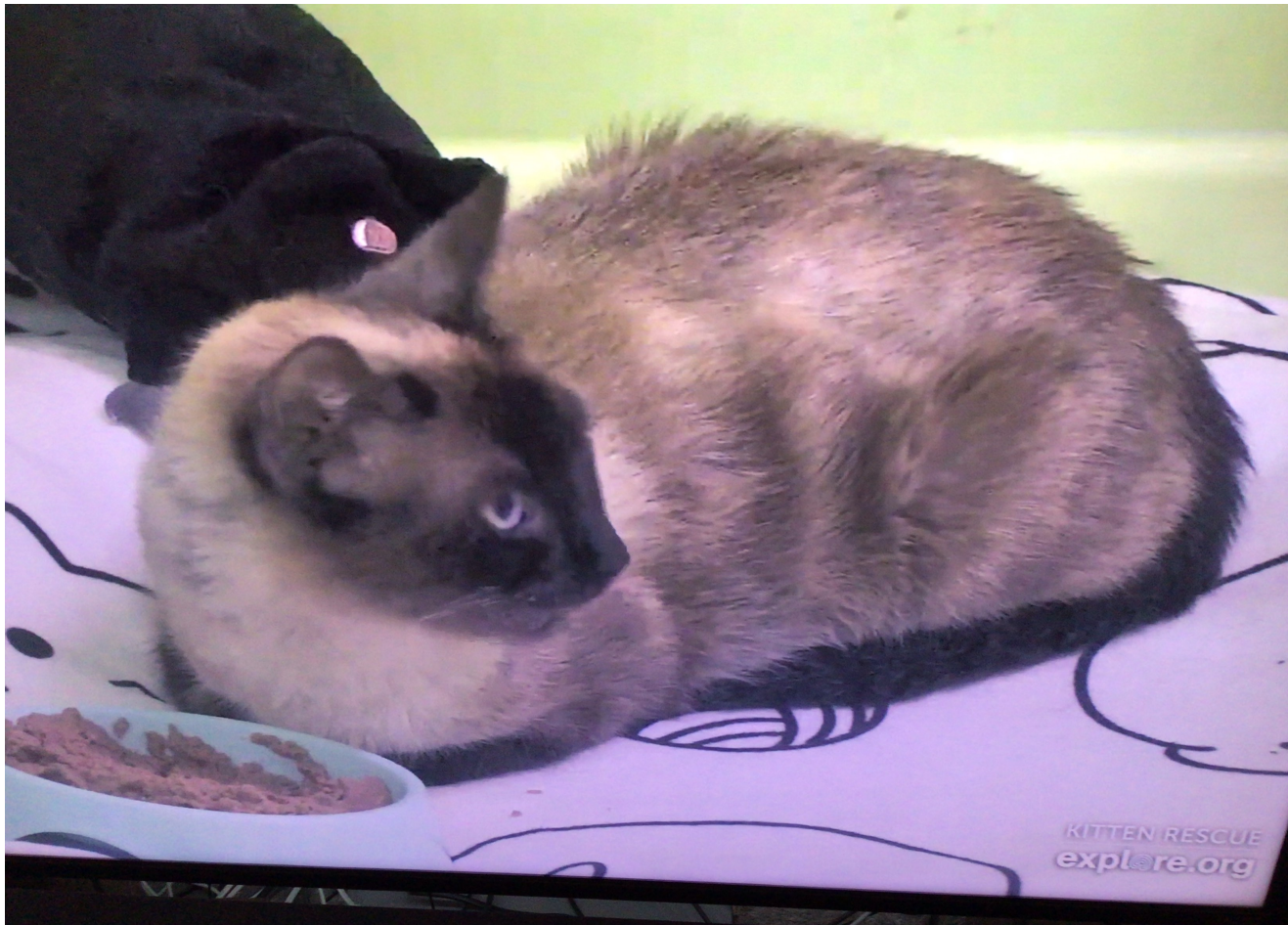

Image above - Lunch, who is watching the opening ceremony for the Catolympics.

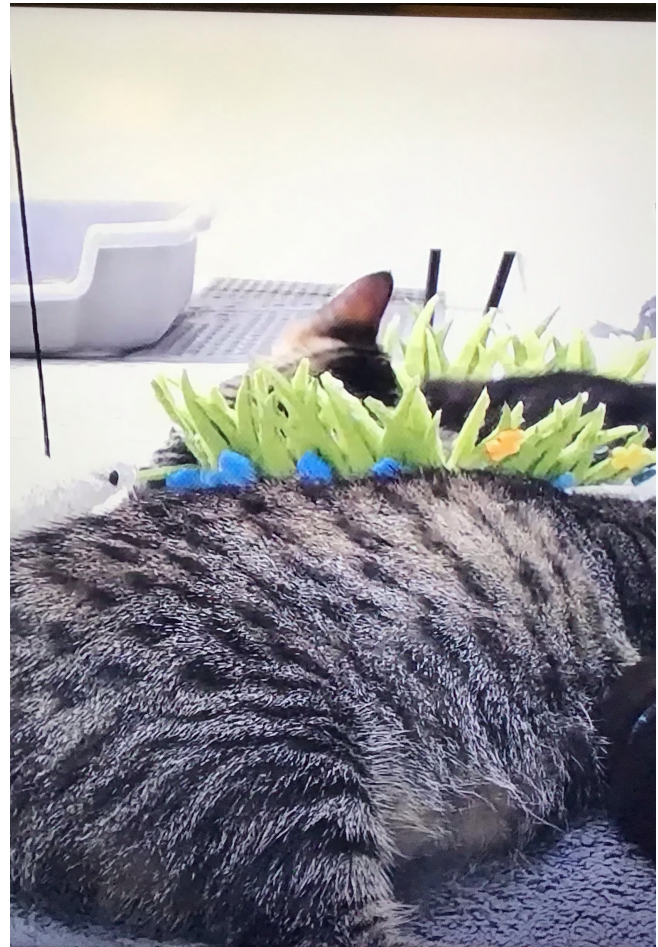
