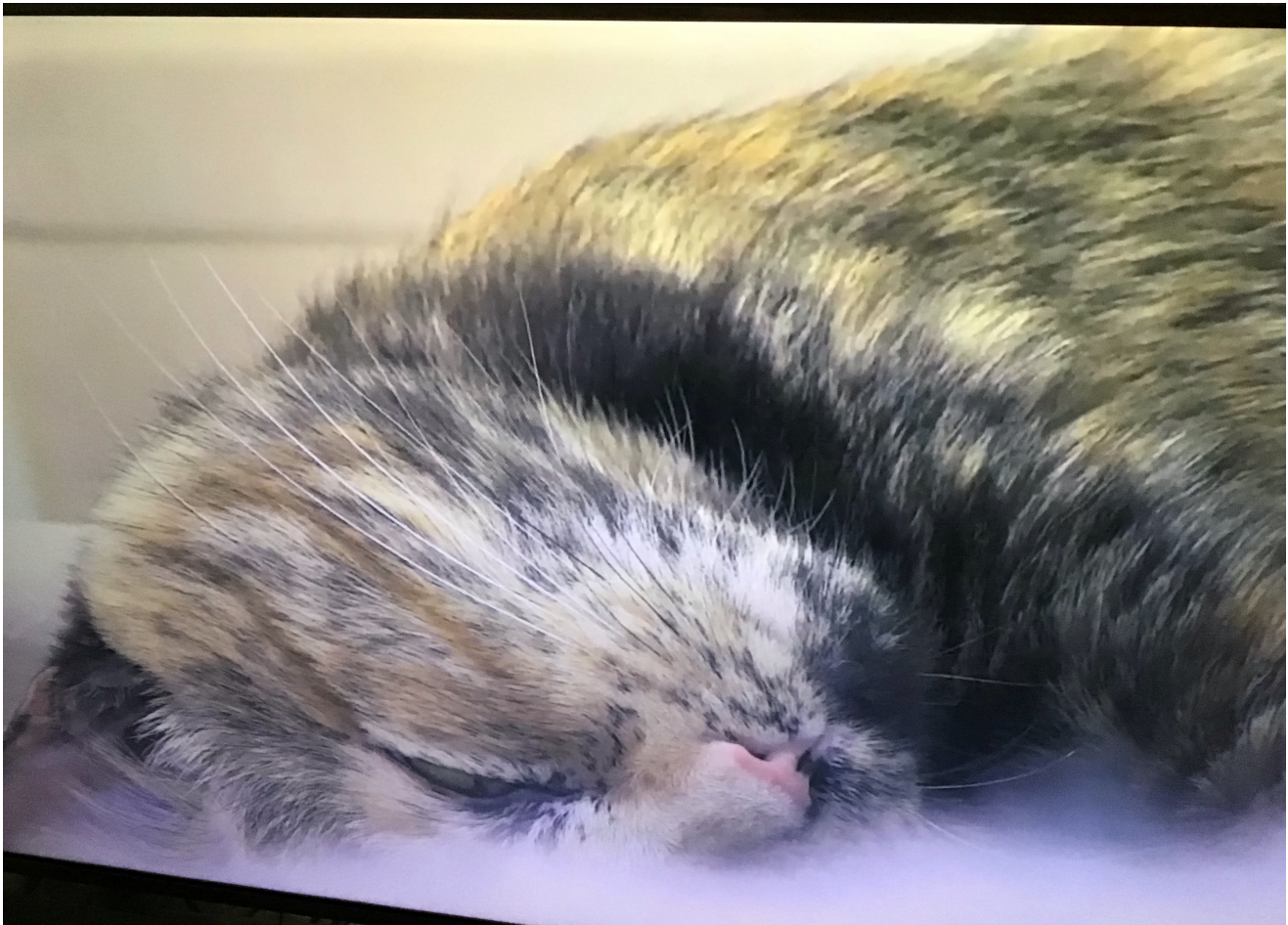

CATS ILLUSTRATED
