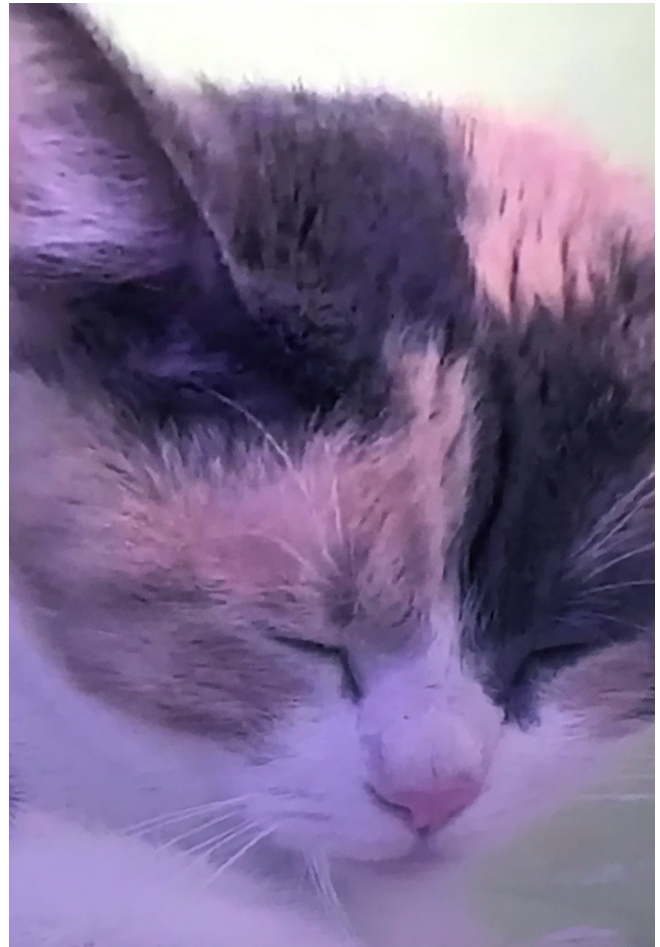


Image above - Juliet, who's first words of the day were "slower please" directed at Blackpelt.
