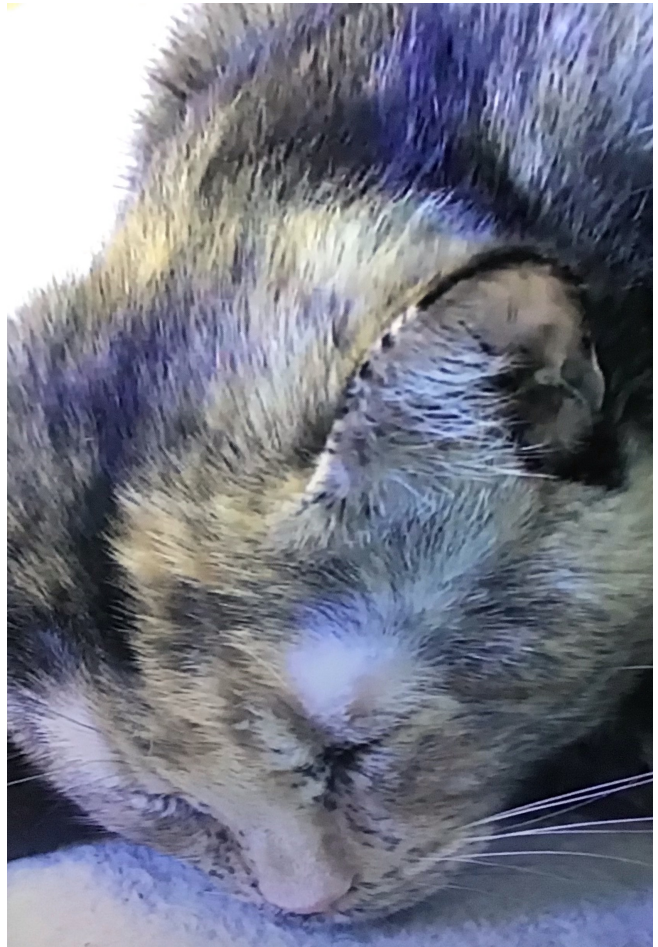


Image above - Judy, who's disappointed her team didn't survive longer but is glad she got to fight Rudy.
