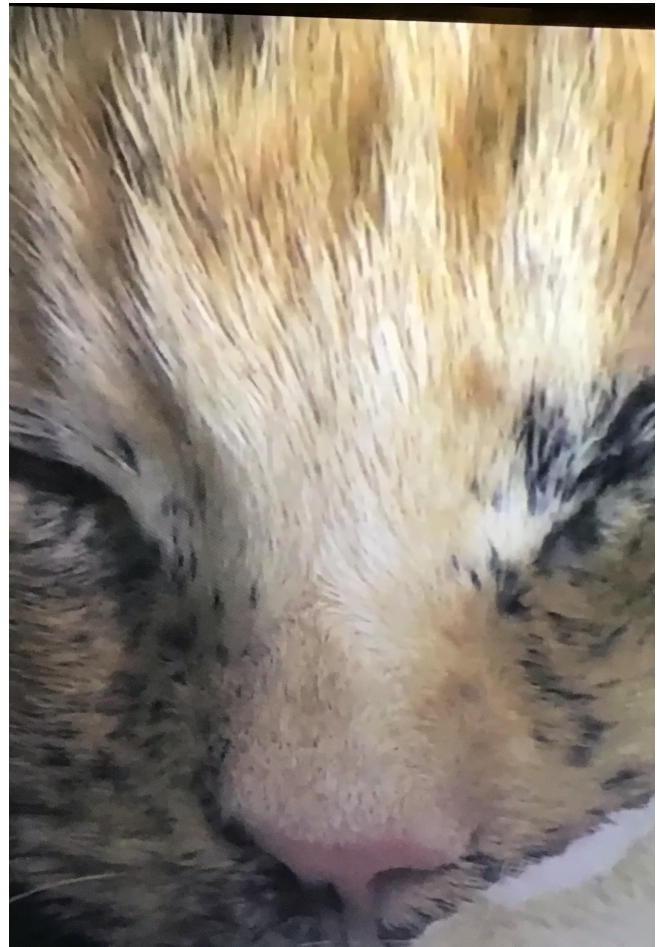


Image above - Judy, who is thinking about trying to burn Rudy's house down.
