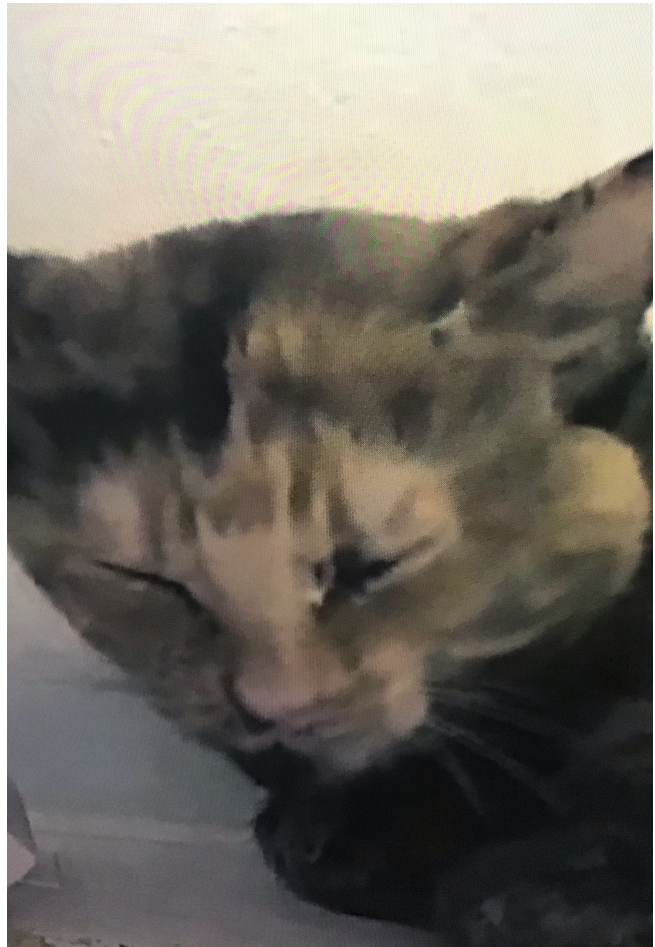


Image above - Judy, who’s going to spook Rudy’s kittens so much with her decorations that they pee their costumes.
