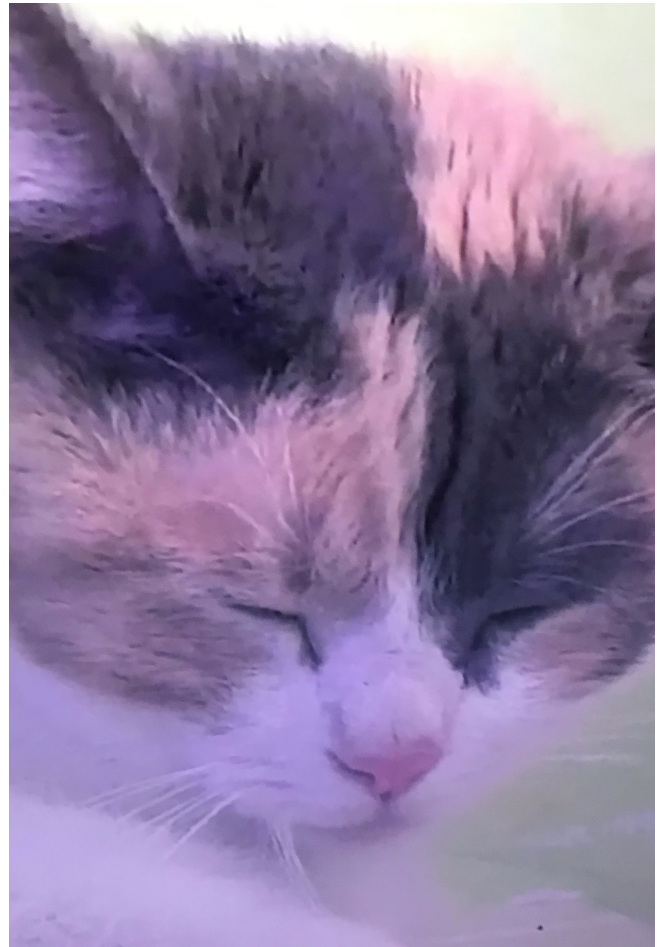


Image above - Juliet, who didn't make her kittens do anything with their candy because they hadn't gotten much.
