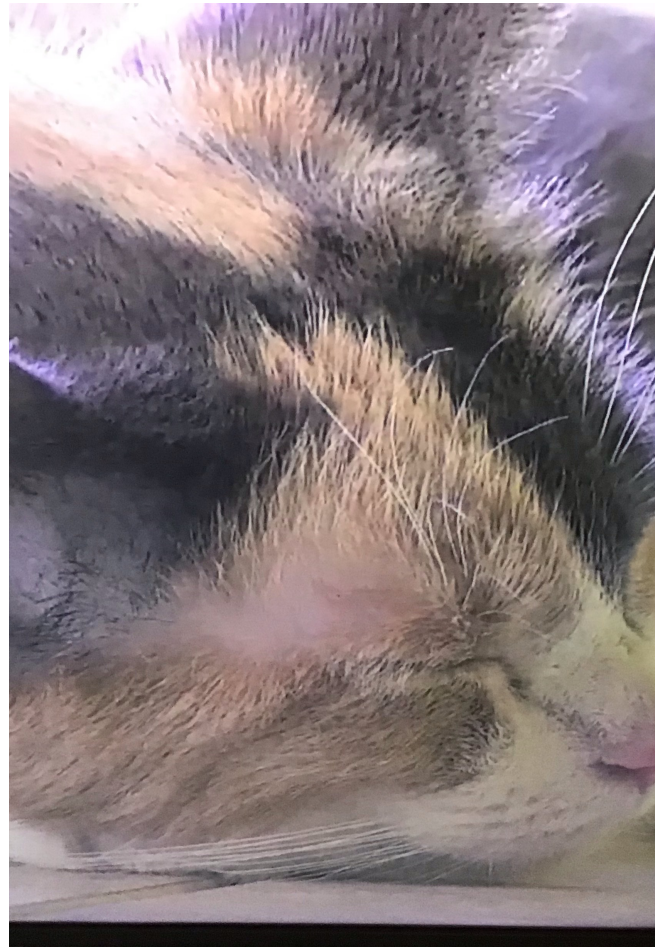


Image above - Juliet, who's going to ask Lunch a serious question.
