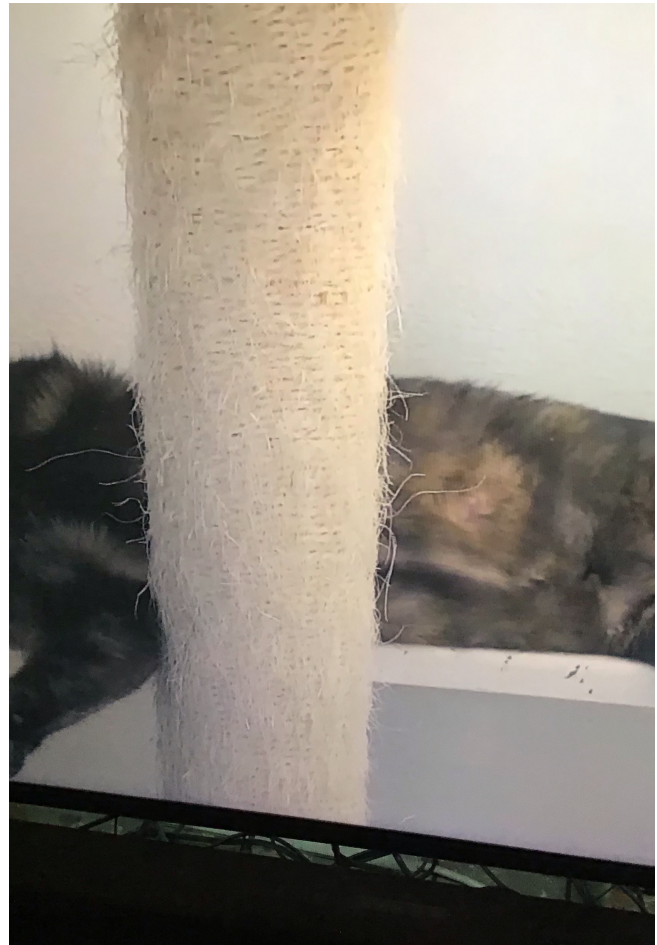


Image above - Judy, who's going to savor her three bottles of wine.
