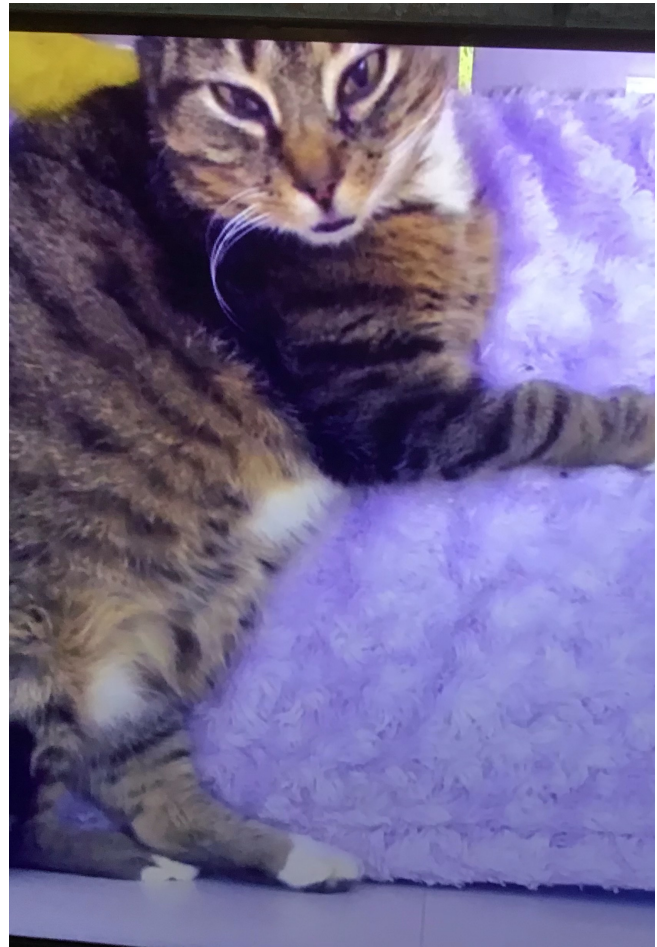


Image above - Harvey, whose schedule is the opposite of North — he works five hours a day, and sleeps sixteen.
