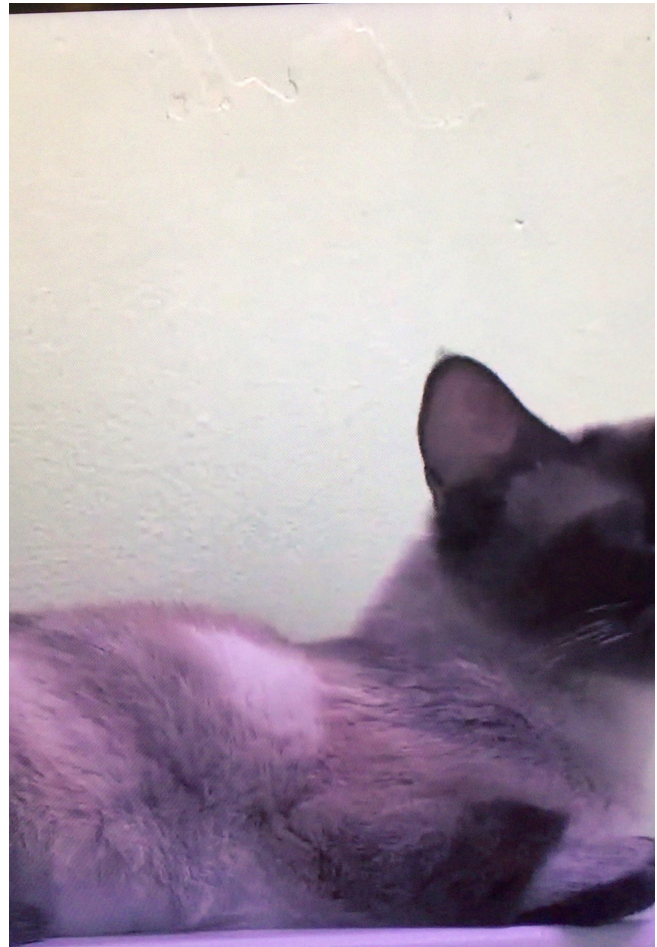


Image above - Lunch, who's thinking about selling K4K candies in her Luncheon.
