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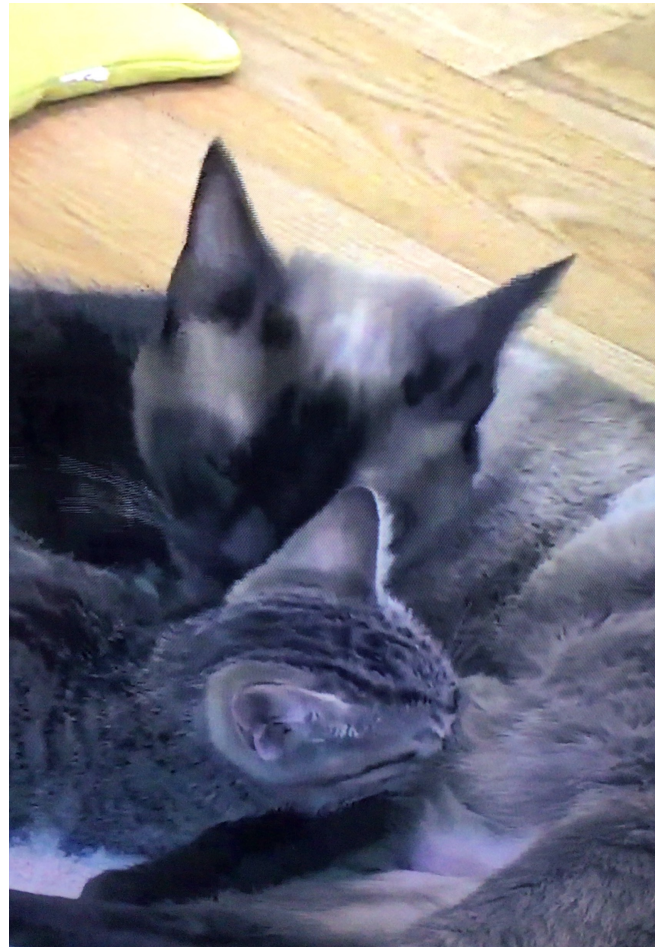


Image above - Lunch, who'll have to try some real Twinkies to compare them with her Twinkies.
