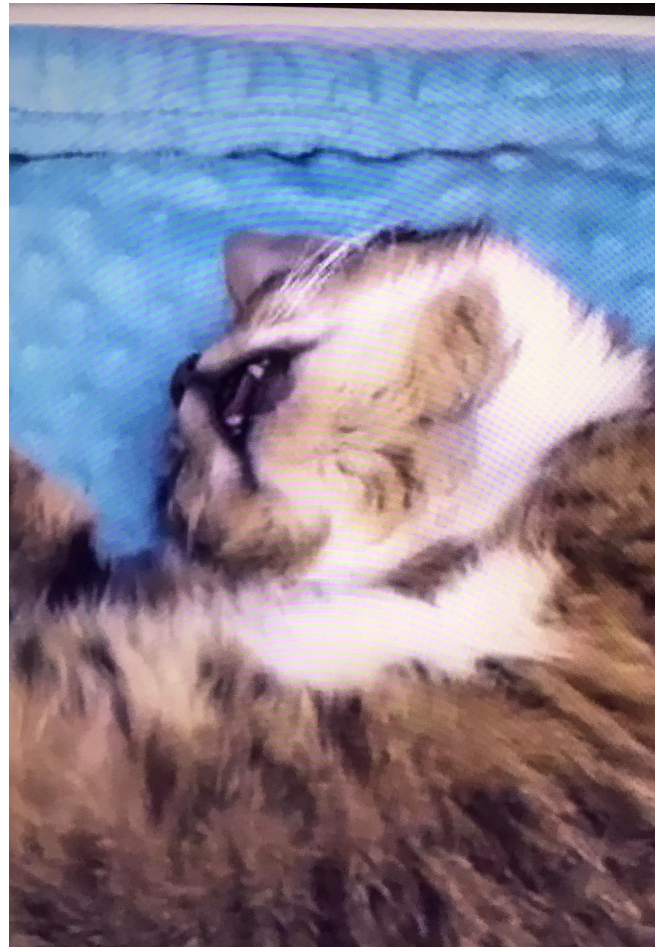


Image above - Harvey, who'll always come to Lunch's Luncheon for sugar fries.
