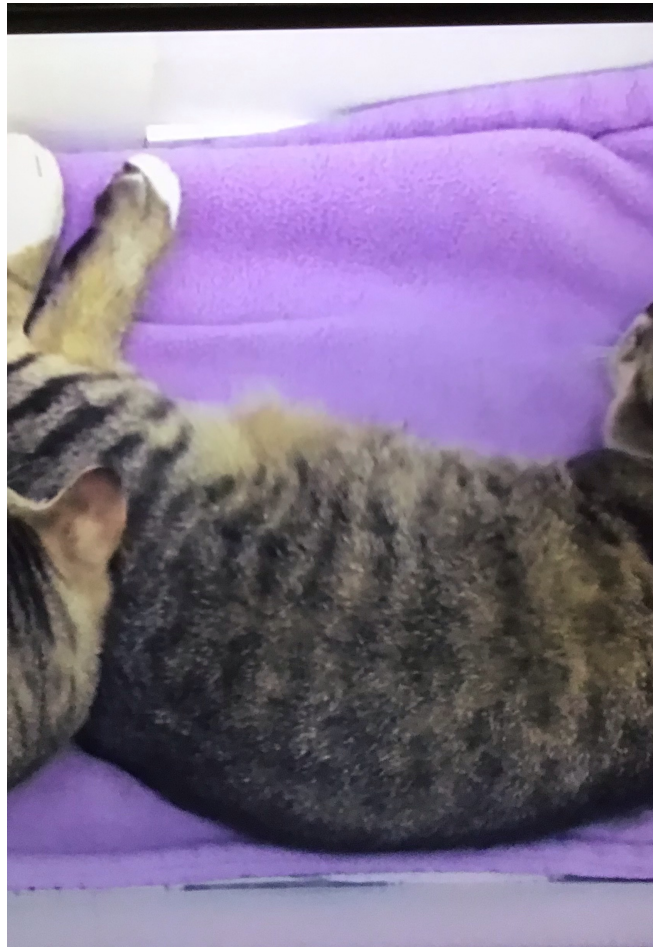


Image above - Harvey, who doesn't watch that much TV, but he'll be watching this competition.
