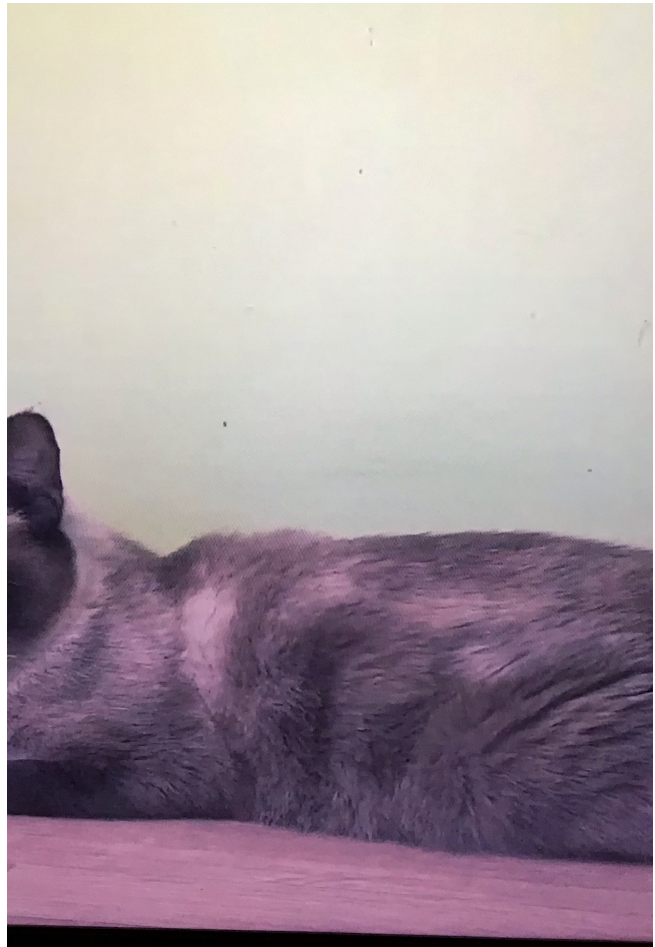


Image above - Lunch, who knows she could down a couple pounds of potato chips.
