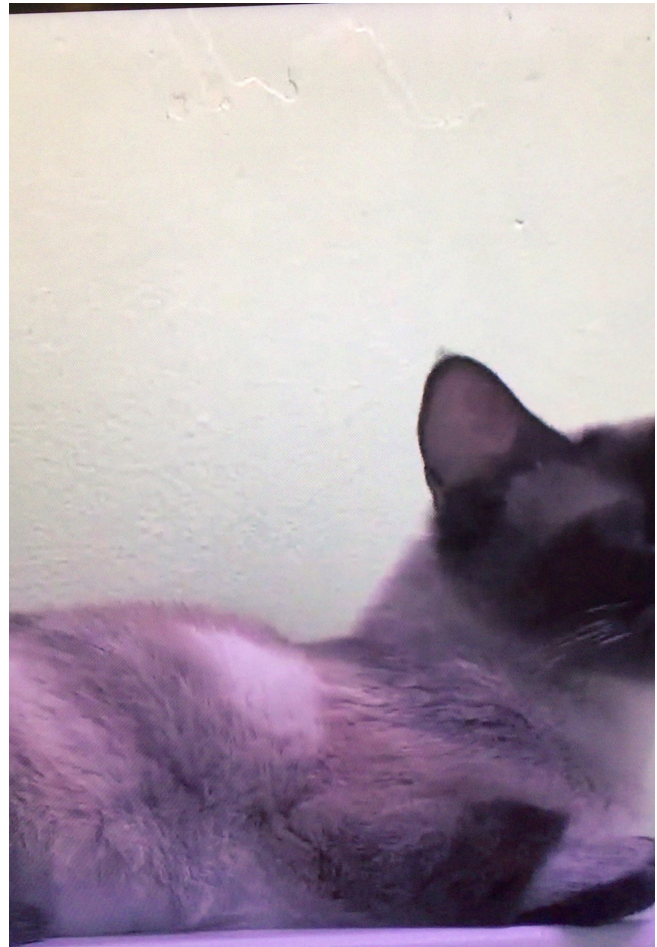


Image above - Lunch, who's not going to let any cat tamper with food from her luncheon.
