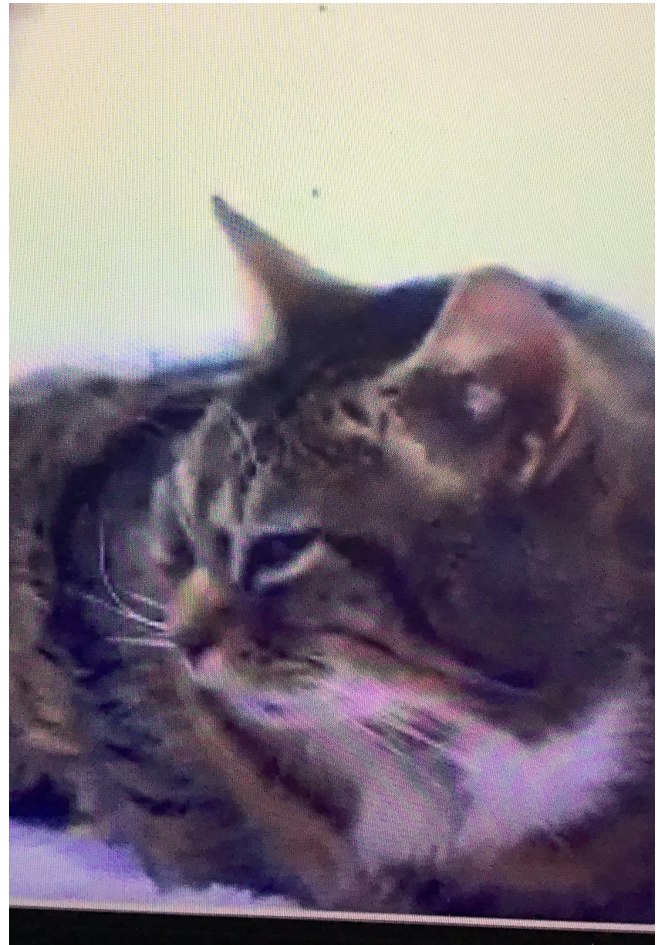


Image above - Harvey, who's too sad to eat sugar fries right now.
