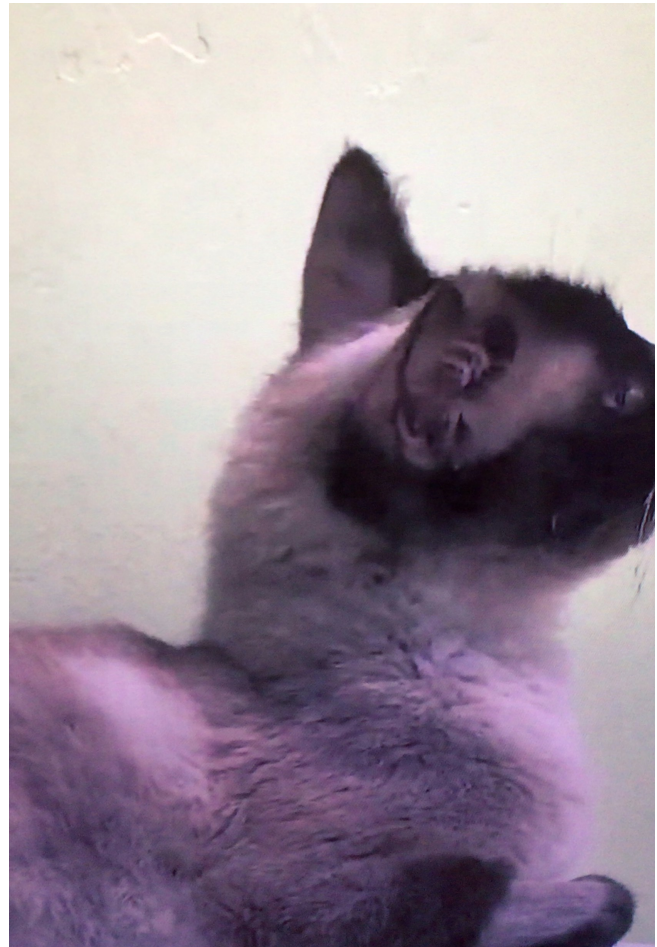


Image above - Lunch, who wishes her kittens weren't involved in this.
