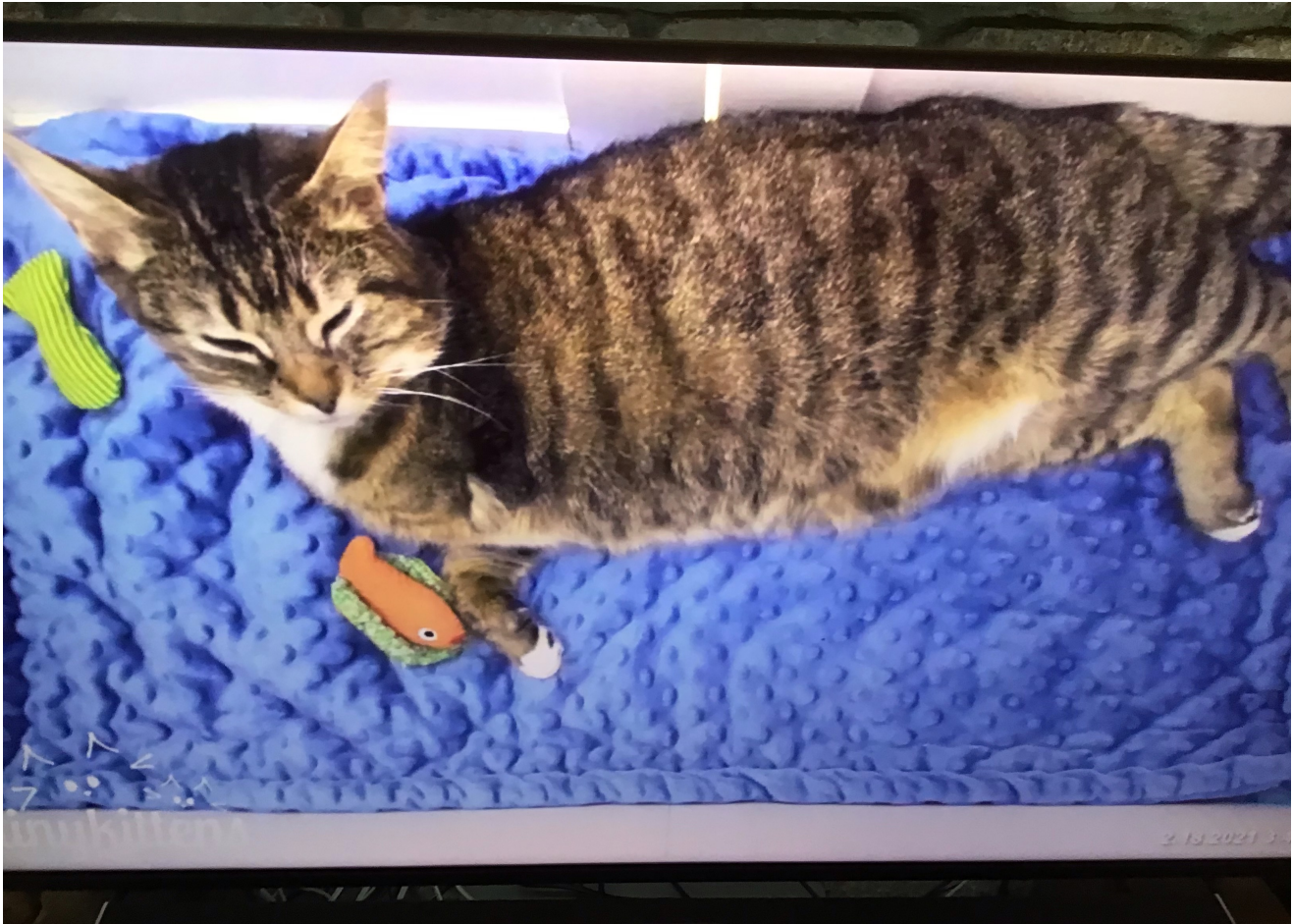

CATS ILLUSTRATED
