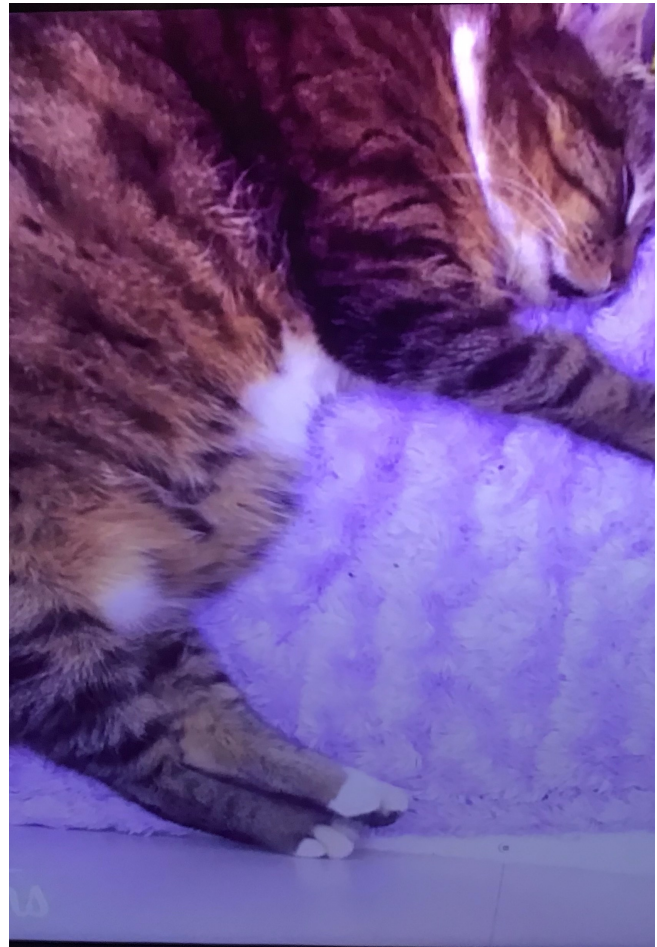


Image above - Harvey, who has put away all of his sugar cubes in a lock box just in case.
