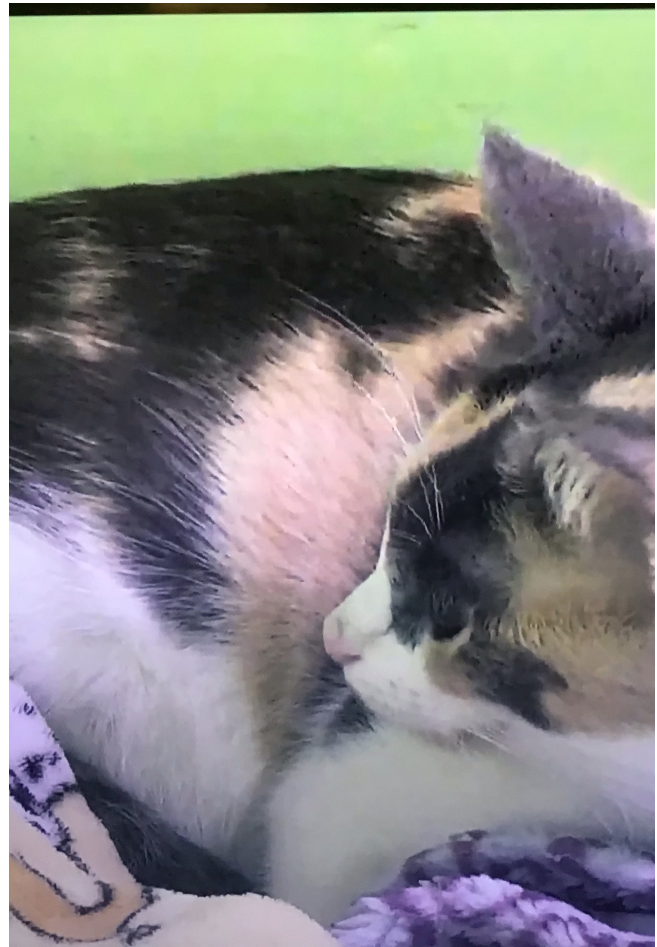


Image above - Juliet, who was in the pool when the dye bomb went off, and will ground any of her kittens who were involved in it.
