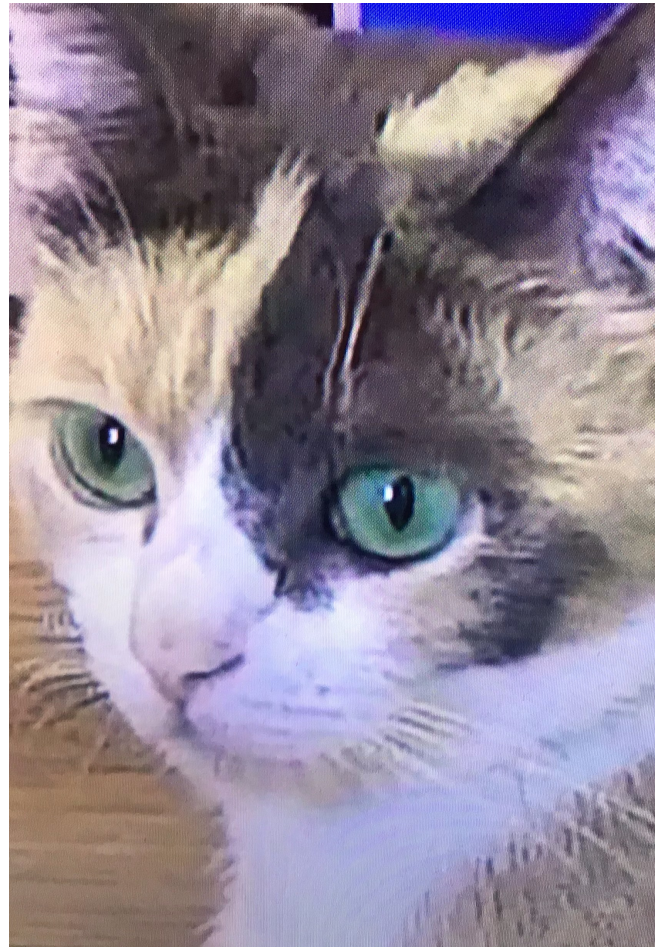


Image above - Juliet, who is thinking about taking her kittens to an amusement park.
