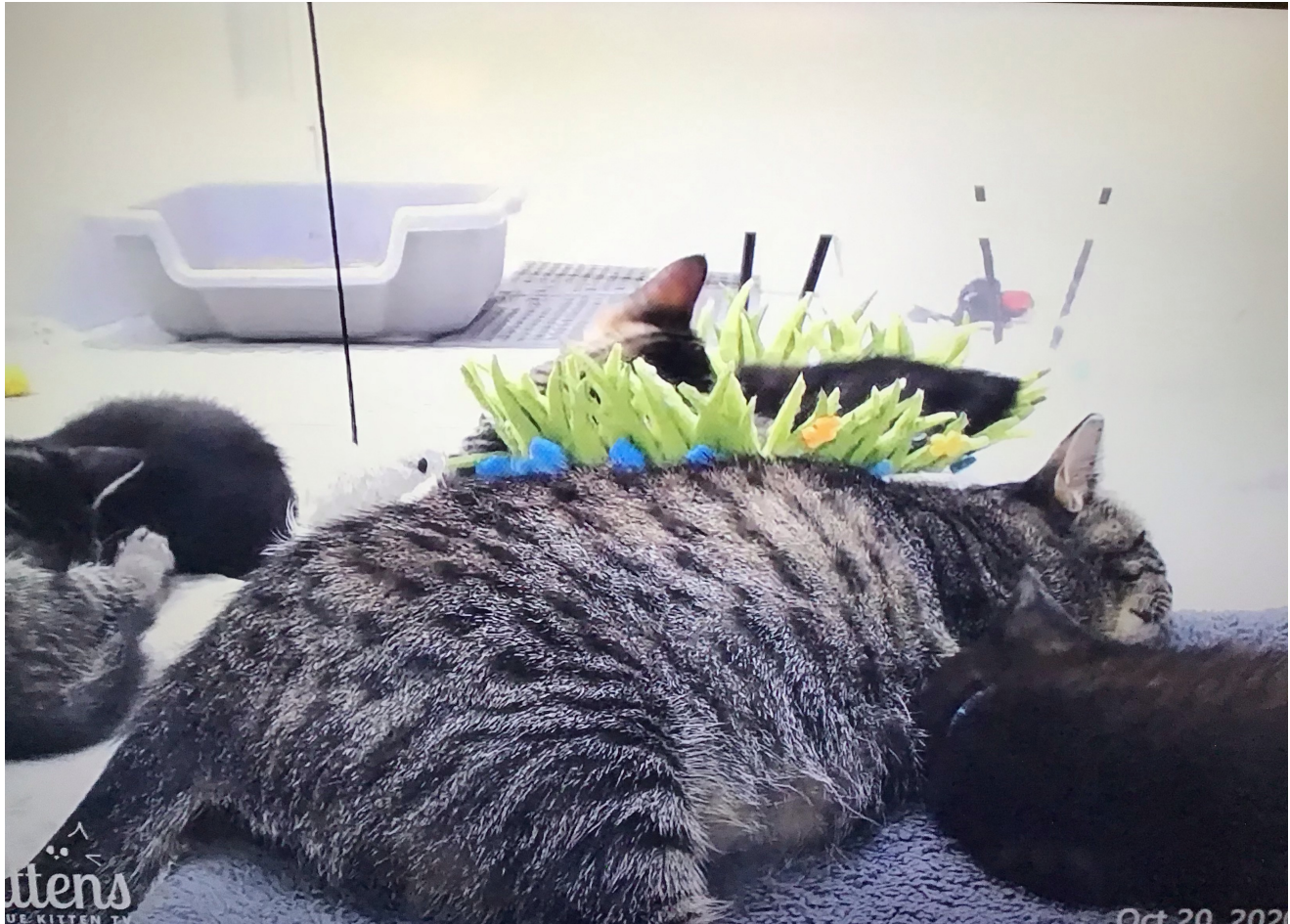

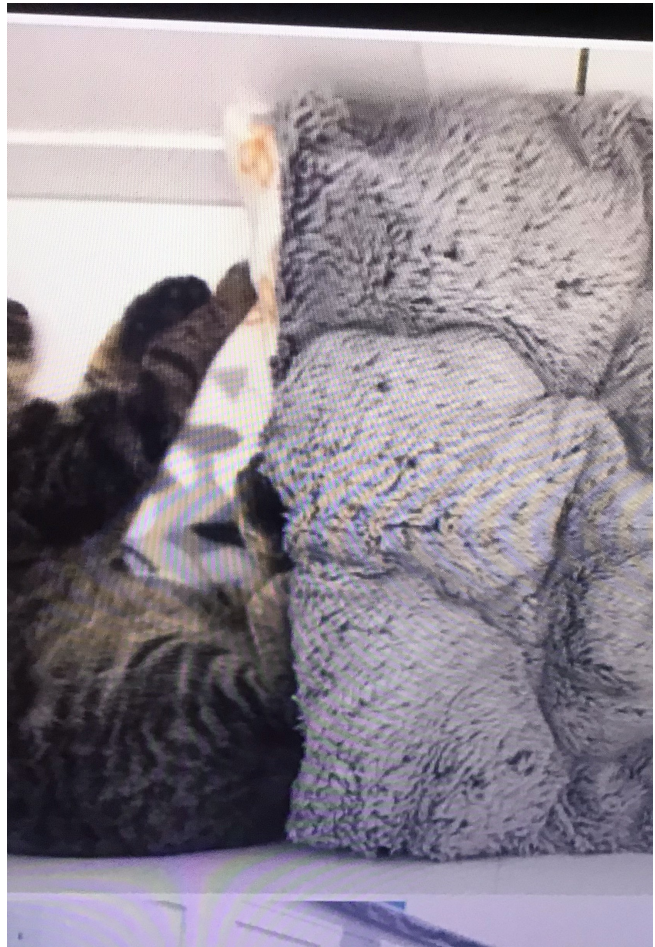


Image above - Makenna, who doesn't mind taking care of Mavis's kittens for a few days.
