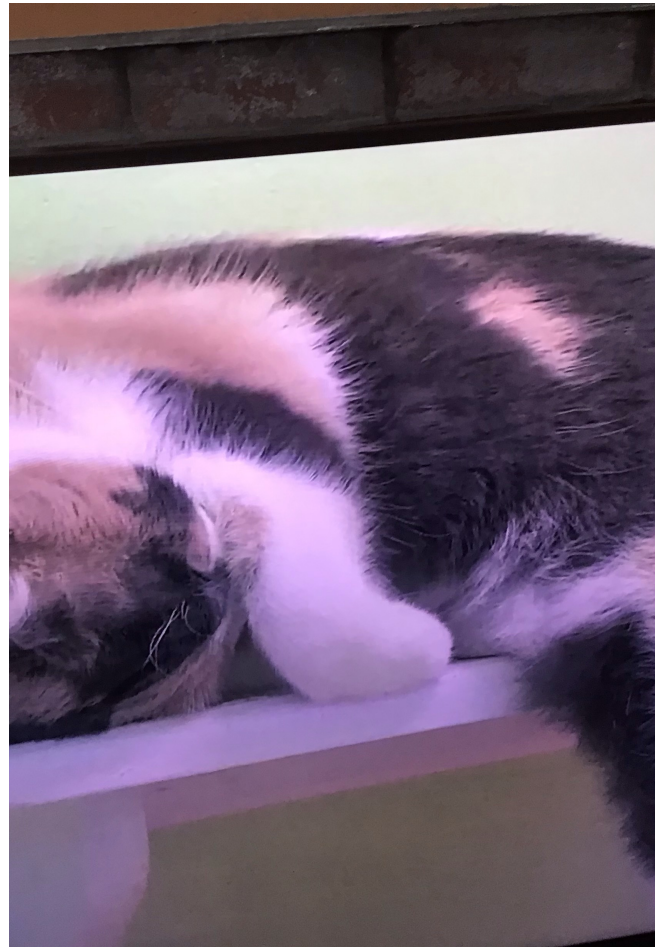


Image above - Juliet, who knows that Spring Break doesn't last forever.
