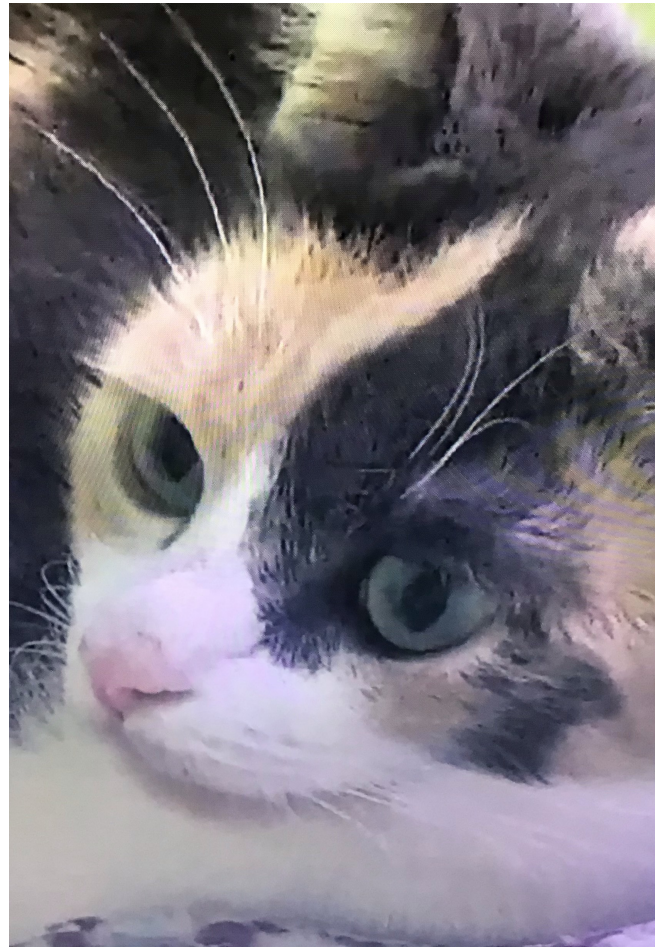


Image above - Juliet, who isn't happy that the instant ramen at the grocery store was cleaned out.
