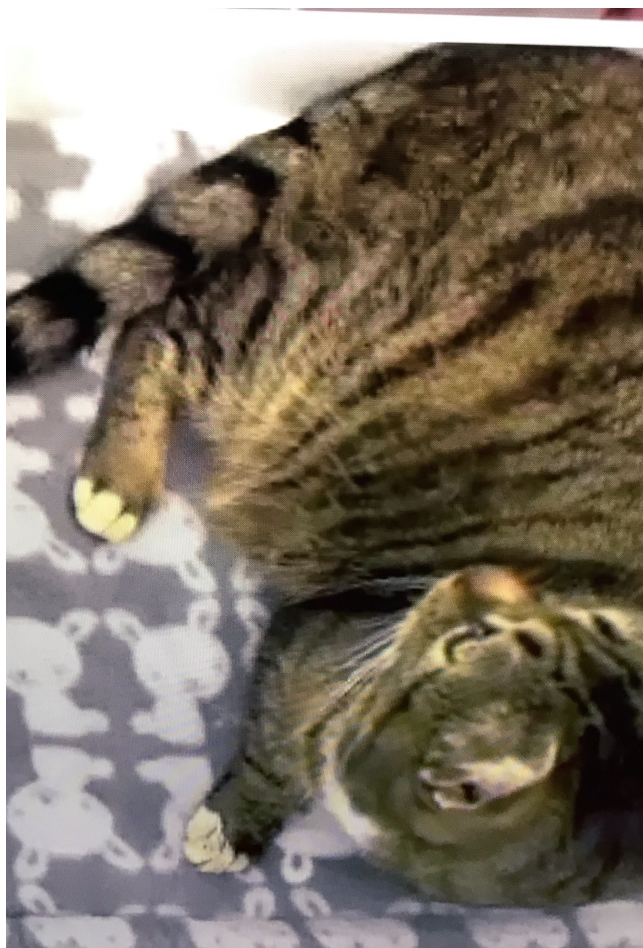


Image above - Harvey, who's too tired to eat sugar cubes.
