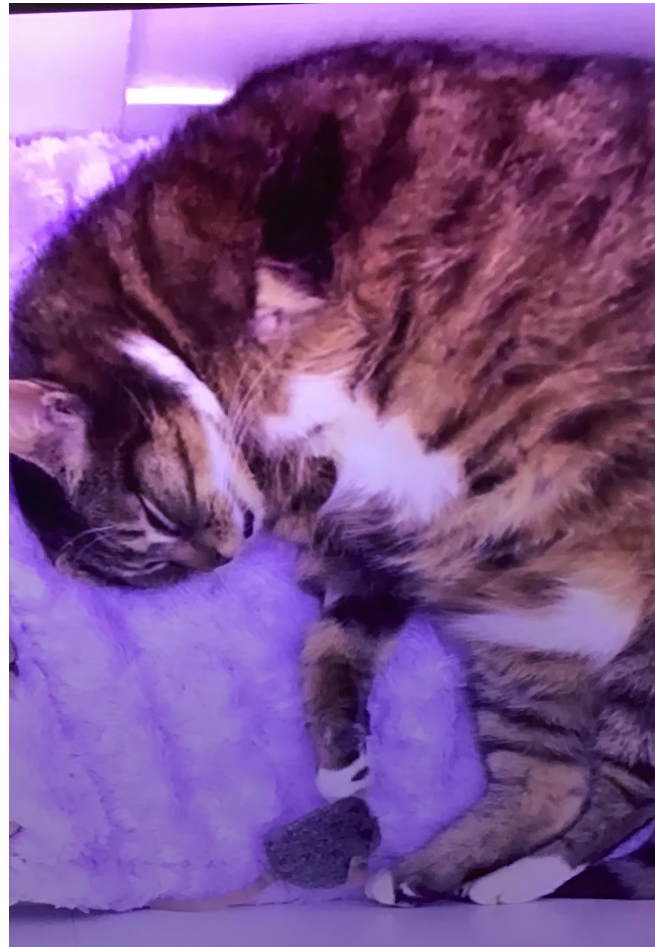


Image above - Harvey who is very glad that North is past that stage of trickery in life.
