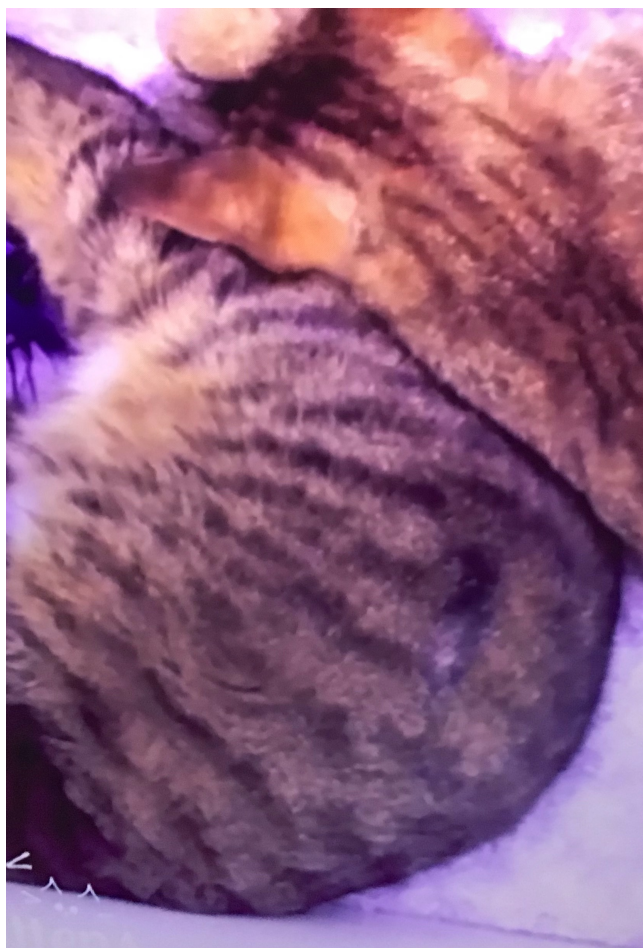


Image above - Harvey, who would jump in his own fridge if it were big enough.
