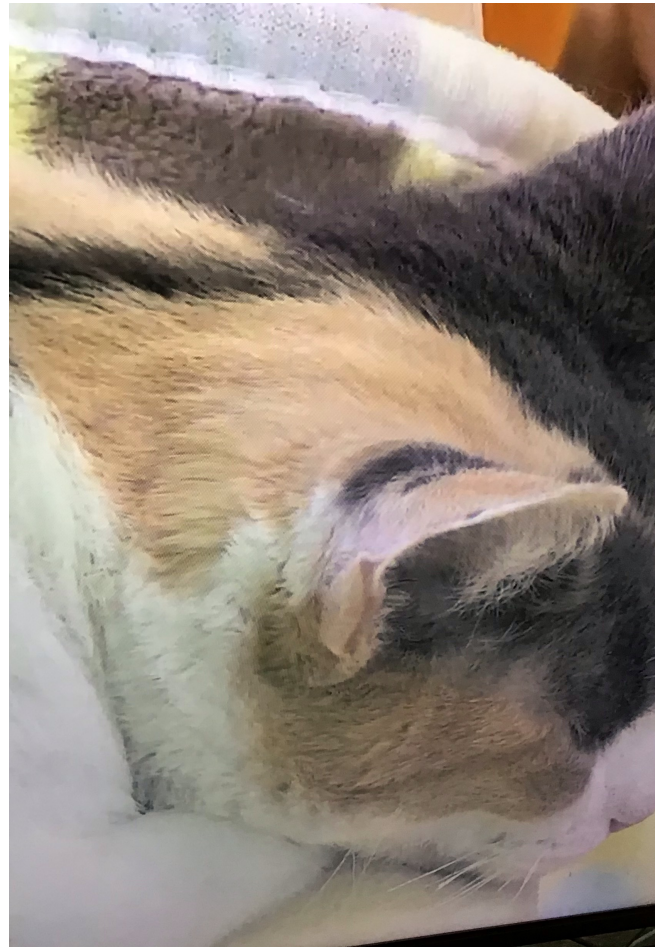


Image above - Rudy, who likes lemonade better than soda, but doesn't want to tell her kittens.
