Image above - Juliet, who is not happy to hear this.

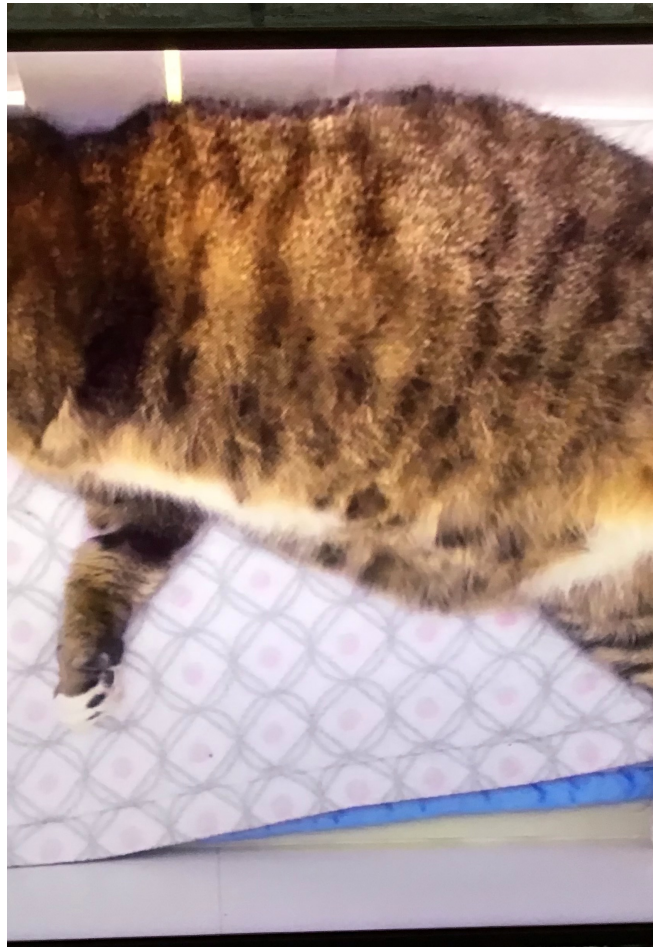
