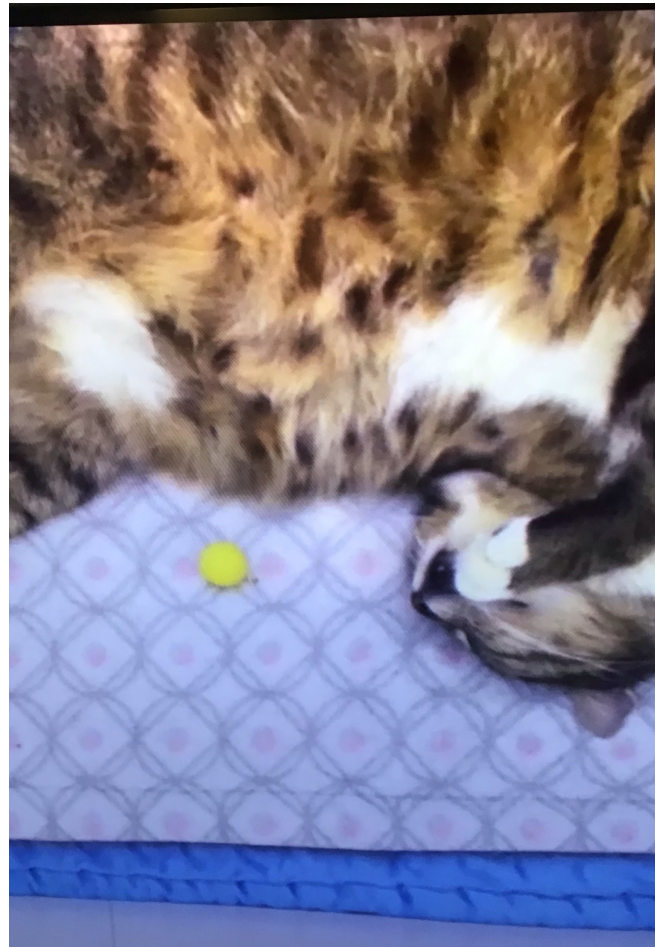


Image above - Harvey, who hangs out at The Wish for Fish too because kittens love him.
