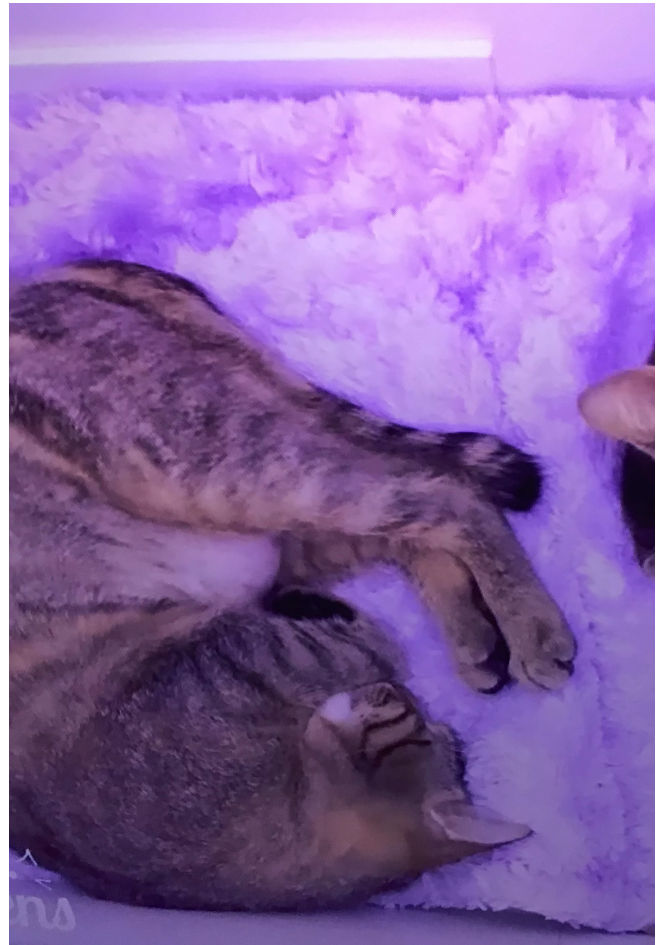


Image above - North, who had a feeling that Harvey was stealing his soda.
